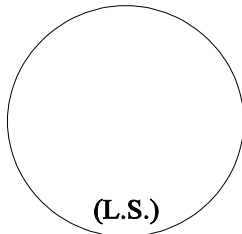
Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Amendment Act 1997 No 83—Proclamation

Explanatory note

The object of this proclamation is to commence the uncommenced provisions of the *Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Amendment Act 1997*. Those provisions relate to the pinioning of birds, the use of electrical devices on animals, the provision of proper and sufficient food and drink to animals, steeplechasing and hurdle races and guidelines for the welfare of farm or companion animals.
