Legal Profession Amendment Act 1996 No 95—Proclamation

Explanatory note

The object of this proclamation is to commence the uncommenced provisions of the *Legal Profession Amendment Act 1996* (other than Schedule 5 [17]). The provisions concerned are:

- (a) Schedule 4 [6] (which inserts section 61 (Money received by solicitor on behalf of another) into the *Legal Profession Act 1987*), and
- (b) Schedule 5 [1], [2], [12], [13], [15], [16], [20], [21] and [23]–[27] (being amendments to the *Legal Profession Act 1987* allowing trust moneys deposited with the Law Society and certain other moneys to be deposited in building societies and credit unions, as well as banks).
