# Drug Misuse and Trafficking Amendment (Prohibited Plants and Drugs) Regulation 2000

under the

Drug Misuse and Trafficking Act 1985

## Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to amend the *Drug Misuse and Trafficking Act 1985* so as:

- (a) to amend the description of several substances specified in the list of prohibited plants and drugs in Schedule 1 to the Act (being Dextropropoxyphene, Diphenoxylate and Tetrahydrocannabinol), and
- (b) to add two substances to Schedule 1 (being 5-(2-aminopropyl)indan and Flunitrazepam).

These amendments largely reflect changes to the Poisons List proclaimed or proposed to be proclaimed under the *Poisons and Therapeutic Goods Act 1966*.

This Regulation is made under the *Drug Misuse and Trafficking Act 1985*, including sections 44 and 45 (the general regulation-making power).

**1    Name of Regulation**

This Regulation is the *Drug Misuse and Trafficking Amendment (Prohibited Plants and Drugs) Regulation 2000*.

**2    Commencement**

This Regulation commences on 21 August 2000.

**3    Amendment of Drug Misuse and Trafficking Act 1985**

The *Drug Misuse and Trafficking Act 1985* is amended as set out in Schedule 1.

Insert “Three or” after “Schedule” in the matter relating to Diphenoxylate under the heading “Prohibited plant or prohibited drug”.

**[4] Schedule 1**

Insert after the matter relating to Fentanyl:

Flunitrazepam . . . . .	0.6g	0.2g	1g	0.1kg	0.5kg	—
-------------------------	------	------	----	-------	-------	---

**[5] Schedule 1**

Omit “except where separately specified in this Schedule” from the matter relating to Tetrahydrocannabinol under the heading “Prohibited plant or prohibited drug”.

Insert instead:

except:

- (a) where separately specified in this Schedule, or
- (b) in hemp seed oil, containing 50mg/kg or less of tetrahydrocannabinols, when labelled “Not for internal use” or “Not to be taken”, or
