# Liquor and Registered Clubs Legislation Amendment Act 2000 No 62—Proclamation

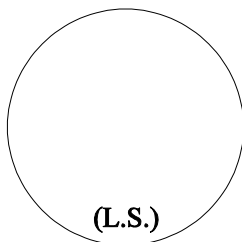

I, the Honourable Gordon Samuels AC, CVO, Governor of the State of New South Wales, with the advice of the Executive Council, and in pursuance of section 2 (2) of the *Liquor and Registered Clubs Legislation Amendment Act 2000*, do, by this my Proclamation, appoint 1 September 2000 as the day on which the following provisions of that Act commence:

- (a) Schedule 1 [1]–[37], [45] and [48]–[51],
- (b) Schedule 2 [1],
- (c) Schedule 2 [2] (except to the extent that it inserts a definition of *employee* in section 4 (1) of the *Registered Clubs Act 1976*),
- (d) Schedule 2 [3]–[19].
