Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to provide that only persons employed under Part 2 of the *Public Sector Management Act 1988* or the *Zoological Parks Board Act 1973* are entitled to pay certain reduced registration and annual fees.

This Regulation is made under the *Veterinary Surgeons Act 1986*, including sections 16 (1) (c) and 19 and section 71 (the general regulation-making power).
