Children and Young Persons (Care and Protection) Act 1998 No 157— Proclamation



- (a) Chapters 2–6 (except sections 28 and 58),
- (b) Parts 1 and 2 of Chapter 7,
- (c) Division 1 of Part 3 of Chapter 8,
- (d) Chapter 9 (except section 176),
- (e) section 200,
- (f) section 229,
- (g) Chapter 15 (except section 236),
- (h) sections 246–254, 256, 257 and 265.

Children and Young Persons (Care and Protection) Act 1998 No 157—Proclamation

Explanatory note

The object of this proclamation is to further commence provisions of the *Children and Young Persons (Care and Protection) Act 1998*. Other provisions of the Act were commenced by proclamations published in Government Gazette No 48 of 17 April 2000, p 3350, and Government Gazette No 148 of 17 November 2000, p 11763. The provisions of the Act that remain to be commenced are sections 28 and 58, Part 3 of Chapter 7, Chapter 8 (except Division 1 of Part 3), Chapter 10 (except section 178), Chapters 11–13, section 236, Chapter 16, section 255 and Schedules 1 and 2.
