Water Management Act 2000 No 92—Proclamation

GORDON SAMUELS, Governor

I, the Honourable Gordon Samuels AC, CVO, Governor of the State of New South Wales, with the advice of the Executive Council, and in pursuance of section 2 of the *Water Management Act 2000*, do, by this my Proclamation, appoint 1 January 2001 as the day on which the following provisions of that Act commence:

- (a) Schedule 7 in its application to:
 - (i) all of the Acts referred to in that Schedule other than the *Rivers and Foreshores Improvement Act 1948* and the *Water Act 1912*, and
 - (ii) Parts 2 and 3 of the *Rivers and Foreshores Improvement Act 1948*, and
 - (iii) section 7, and Parts 3, 4, 6, 7 and 10, of the *Water Act 1912*,
- (b) Schedule 8.1, 8.3, 8.5–8.7, 8.9, 8.10, 8.11 [3], 8.12, 8.13, 8.16 [1]–[3] and [5], 8.17, 8.18, 8.20, 8.22, 8.23, 8.24 [1] and [2], 8.25 [4] and [5], 8.26, 8.27 [1]–[4] and [6], 8.28 [1], 8.29 [7] and [9].
