Motor Trade Legislation Amendment Act 2001 No 86—Proclamation

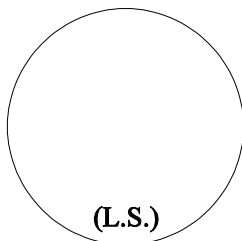

I, Professor Marie Bashir AC, Governor of the State of New South Wales, with the advice of the Executive Council, and in pursuance of section 2 of the *Motor Trade Legislation Amendment Act 2001*, do, by this my Proclamation, appoint 1 March 2002 as the day on which the following provisions of that Act commence:

- (a) sections 1 and 2, and sections 3 and 4 in their application to the amendments referred to in paragraphs (b) and (c),
- (b) Schedule 1 [1]–[3], [5], [7], [9], [12]–[14], [22], [27], [34], [35], [37], [43]–[45], [47], [51] and [54]–[58],
- (c) Schedule 2 [19], [20], [43], [44], [48], [50]–[54], [58]–[63], [70]–[72], [74]–[76] and [78]–[81].
