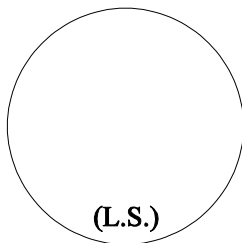
Police Service Amendment (Complaints) Act 2001 No 79—Proclamation
