I, Professor Marie Bashir AC, Governor of the State of New South Wales, with the advice of the Executive Council, and in pursuance of section 2 of the *Police Service Amendment (NSW Police) Act 2002*, do, by this my Proclamation, appoint 12 July 2002 as the day on which that Act commences except for the following:

- (a) Schedule 1 [8],
- (b) Schedule 1 [12],
- (c) Schedule 2.1,
- (d) Schedule 2.2.

Explanatory note

The object of this proclamation is to commence the *Police Service Amendment (NSW Police) Act 2002* except for certain provisions (that make amendments to the *Police Service Act 1990*, the *Associations Incorporation Act 1984* and the *Business Names Act 1962*) relating to the use of the word "police" in operating names under which any activity is carried out, and a provision consequential on the *Compensation Court Repeal Act 2002* which has not yet commenced.
