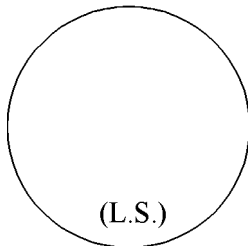
Legislation Review Amendment Act 2002 No 77
