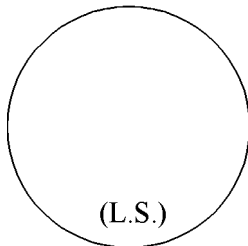
Justices Legislation Repeal and Amendment Act 2001 No 121
