
Road Transport (General) Amendment (Operator Onus Offences) Act 2002 No 11

Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to commence so much of the provisions of the *Road Transport (General) Amendment (Operator Onus Offences) Act 2002* as:

- (a) increase from 6 months to 1 year the period during which proceedings for a parking offence, camera-detected traffic light offence or camera-recorded speeding offence may be taken, and
- (b) increase the penalty for a corporation that is a responsible person for a vehicle and that fails to nominate, or fails to exercise reasonable diligence to ascertain, the person in charge of the vehicle in respect of a parking offence, camera-detected traffic light offence or camera-recorded speeding offence.
