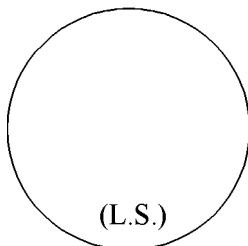
Legal Profession Amendment (National Competition Policy Review) Act 2002 No 25
