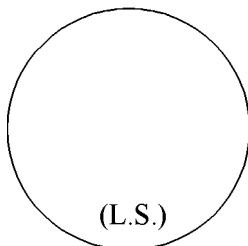
Crimes Legislation Amendment Act 2002

## Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to commence amendments to the *Mental Health (Criminal Procedure) Act 1990* that:

- (a) enable a person who breaches a condition of a discharge by a magistrate under section 32 of the Act to be brought back before the Magistrate, and
- (b) clarify the categories of persons that may be dealt with under section 32.
