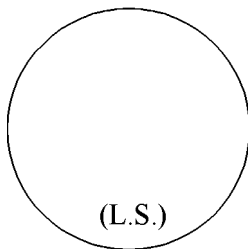
Crimes Legislation Amendment (Terrorism) Act 2004 No 48
