Explanatory note

The object of this Order is to declare certain laws of other Australian jurisdictions to be corresponding laws to the *Valuers Act 2003* of New South Wales.

The Order allows certain qualifications and disqualifications under those interstate laws relating to registration as a valuer to be considered and taken into account in this jurisdiction.

1 Name of Order

This Order is the *Valuers (Corresponding Laws) Order 2005*.

2 Definition

In this Order:

the Act means the *Valuers Act 2003*.

3 Corresponding laws

For the purposes of section 3 of Act, the following laws are declared to be laws that correspond to the Act:

- (a) the *Valuers Registration Act 1992* of Queensland,
- (b) the *Land Valuers Act 1994* of South Australia,
- (c) the *Land Valuers Licensing Act 1978* of Western Australia,
- (d) the *Land Valuers Act 2001* of Tasmania.
