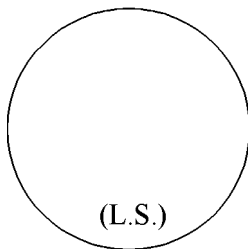
Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Amendment
