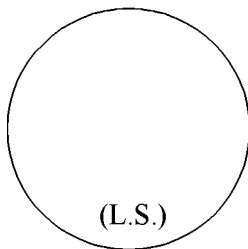
### Dust Diseases Tribunal Amendment (Claims Resolution) Act 2005 No 22

### Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to commence the provisions of the *Dust Diseases Tribunal Amendment (Claims Resolution) Act 2005*, other than Schedule 1 [4], [6], [8], [10]–[13] and [17], Schedule 3 and Schedule 4 [1].

Schedule 1 [4], [6], [8], [10]–[13] and [17] and Schedule 4 [1] are provisions that are consequential on the commencement of the *Civil Procedure Act 2005*.

Schedule 3 comprises of provisions that make amendments to the *Civil Procedure Act 2005* and will commence on the date of assent to that Act.
