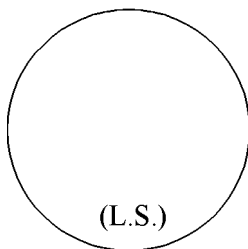

I, Professor Marie Bashir AC, Governor of the State of New South Wales, with the advice of the Executive Council, and in pursuance of section 2 of the *Independent Commission Against Corruption Amendment Act 2005*, do, by this my Proclamation, appoint:

- (a) 1 June 2005 as the day on which sections 1–4 of, and Schedule 1 [2] (to the extent to which it inserts definitions of *Inspector* and *officer of the Inspector* into the *Independent Commission Against Corruption Act 1988*), [23] (to the extent to which it inserts sections 57A and 57E into that Act), [27], [59], [60] and [64] and Schedule 2.1 to, that Act commence, and
- (b) 6 June 2005 as the day on which Schedule 1 [1], [4], [6]–[12], [15], [21], [30], [31], [37], [44]–[53], [55], [63], [65] and [66] and Schedule 2.6 to that Act commence.

Proclamation

Explanatory note

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The object of this proclamation is to commence the provisions of the *Independent Commission Against Corruption Amendment Act 2005* other than provisions relating to:

- (a) compulsory examinations and public inquiries (Schedule 1 [18] and various related and consequential amendments), and
- (b) functions of the Inspector of the Independent Commission Against Corruption and members of the staff of the Inspector (Schedule 1 [23] (other than sections 57A and 57E) and various related and consequential amendments), and
- (c) annual reports (Schedule 1 [32]), and
- (d) extending the provisions of the *Police Integrity Commission Act 1996* relating to police officers to other members of NSW Police (Schedule 2.8).
