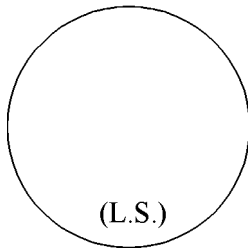
Road Transport (General) Act 2005 No 11
