Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to provide that a reference to a public authority in section 36 of the *Community Land Development Act 1989* is to include the operator of a transacted distribution system to enable statutory easements to be created under that section for the benefit of such operators.

This Regulation is made under the *Electricity Network Assets (Authorised Transactions) Act 2015*, including sections 34 and 59 (general regulation-making power).

This Regulation comprises or relates to matters set out in Schedule 3 to the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1989*, namely, matters of a machinery nature and matters of a savings or transitional nature.

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1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Electricity Network Assets (Authorised Transactions) Regulation 2016*.

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

3 Definition

(1) In this Regulation:

the Act means the *Electricity Network Assets (Authorised Transactions) Act 2015*.

(2) Notes included in this Regulation do not form part of this Regulation.

4 Reference to public authority in the Community Land Development Act 1989

For the purposes of section 34 of the Act, a reference to a public authority in section 36 of the *Community Land Development Act 1989* includes a reference to the operator of a transacted distribution system.
