

GOVERNOR'S SALARY (AMENDMENT) ACT.

An Act to make provision for an increase in the salary of the Governor of New South Wales; for this purpose to amend the Governor's Salary Act, 1901, the Constitution Act, 1902, and certain other Acts in certain respects; and for purposes connected therewith. [Reserved, 1st November, 1955. Assented to, 1st December, 1955.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Governor's Salary (Amendment) Act, 1955."

(2) The Governor's Salary Act, 1901, as amended by subsequent Acts and by this Act, may be cited as the Governor's Salary Act, 1901-1955.

(3) This Act shall be deemed to have commenced on the fourth day of February, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-five.

2. The Governor's Salary Act, 1901, as amended by subsequent Acts, is amended by omitting from subsection one of section two the words "hereafter to be appointed shall be five thousand pounds" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "shall, notwithstanding anything in any other Act contained, be six thousand pounds".
