CITY OF SYDNEY. An Act to declare that an Act passed in the present Session of the Governor and Legislative Council of New South Wales to incorporate the City of Sydney may at any time be altered amended or repealed. [16th August, 1842.]

THEREAS an Act was passed in the present Session of the Legislative Council of New South Wales intituled "An Act to declare " the Town of Sydney to be a City and to incorporate the Inhabitants "thereof" and whereas circumstances have arisen to make it expedient before the said Act can come into operation to remove any cause for doubt which might otherwise exist as to the power of the Governor and Council of New South Wales at any time hereafter to alter or repeal the same Be it therefore hereby declared and enacted by His repealed wholly or in Excellency the Governor of New South Wales with the advice of the Legislative Council thereof That nothing contained in the said Act shall at any time be held or construed to prevent the alteration or repeal of the whole or any part of the same whether such repeal or alteration shall affect the franchises immunities or privileges of the corporate body created by the said Act or otherwise.

May be altered or
