An Act to grant to Her Majesty certain Sums in TREASURER'S SALARY. addition to the present Civil List for the adequate remuneration of the Colonial Treasurer. [12th February, 1857.]

WHEREAS it is considered that the provision made by the Con-Preamble. stitution Act for the remuneration of the Colonial Treasurer is inadequate Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:—

There shall be payable to Her Majesty in every year out of the Provision for in-Consolidated Revenue Fund of the Colony in addition to the Civil crease of salary of List heretofore granted to Her Majesty the further sum of two hundred and fifty pounds by way of increase to the salary of the Colonial Treasurer which sum shall be payable and shall be accounted for in the same manner as the several sums of money comprised in the said Civil List.
