

## Act No. 36, 1899.

LAND TAX  
(COLLECTION).

An Act to make better provision for the collection of the Land Tax for 1899. [22nd December, 1899.]

**B**E it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

For collection of land tax for 1899 assessment-books not deemed incomplete by reason of errors.

1. Notwithstanding section six of the Land and Income Tax (Amendment) Act, 1897, for the collection of the land tax for the year one thousand eight hundred and ninety-nine no assessment-book in respect of land tax shall be deemed incomplete, and no notice given before or after the commencement of this Act in respect of land tax shall be deemed to have been or to be invalid by reason of any error or omission in any such book or in any such notice, or by reason that such book does not contain the names of persons in whom lands have been vested since the thirty-first day of December, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-eight.

But the Commissioners may add to the book the assessment and other prescribed particulars in respect of any land which may be ascertained to be liable to such land tax.

Short title.

2. This Act shall be construed with the Land and Income Tax Assessment Act of 1895, the Land Tax Act of 1895, and the Land and Income Tax (Amendment) Act, 1897, and may be cited as the "Land Tax (Collection) Act, 1899."
