

Act No. 5, 1900.

An Act to amend the law with respect to the rate of interest on verdicts and judgments in the Supreme Court. [3rd August, 1900.]

INTEREST
ON JUDGMENTS
AMENDMENT.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. From and after the passing of this Act the rate of interest on verdicts and judgments in the Supreme Court shall be four per centum per annum in lieu of the rate fixed by the Act number twenty-one of one thousand eight hundred and ninety-nine. Rate of interest on verdicts and judgments.

2. So much of the Act number twenty-one of one thousand eight hundred and ninety-nine as is inconsistent with the provisions of this Act is hereby repealed. Repeal of part of Act No. 21, 1899.

3. This Act may be cited as the "Interest on Judgments Amendment Act, 1900." Short title.
