

Act No. 17, 1907.

An Act to amend the Parramatta Friendly Societies' Hall Site Vesting Act. [23rd December, 1907.]

PARRAMATTA
FRIENDLY
SOCIETIES' HALL
SITE (AMENDMENT).

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Parramatta Friendly Societies' Hall Site (Amendment) Act, 1907." Short title.

2. The Parramatta Friendly Societies' Hall Site Vesting Act is amended as follows:— Amendment of Parramatta Friendly Societies Hall Site Vesting Act.

- (a) In the preamble, by inserting the words "trustees of the" before "Parramatta" where secondly occurring, and by omitting the words "incorporated under Part V of the Friendly Societies Act, 1873."
- (b) In section two, by inserting before the word "Parramatta" the words "trustees of the" and by omitting the words "institute under the powers conferred by the Friendly Societies Act, 1873" and inserting in lieu thereof the word "trustees."
