

JURY (AMENDMENT) ACT.

Act No. 33, 1918.

George V, An Act to exempt certain commercial travellers and
No. 33. mining managers from serving upon a jury ;
and to amend the Jury Act, 1912. [Assented
to, 3rd December, 1918.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty,
by and with the advice and consent of the Legis-
lative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South
Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of
the same, as follows :—

Short title. **1.** This Act may be cited as the "Jury (Amendment)
Act, 1918."

Amendment
of s. 5 of
Principal
Act. **2.** Section five of the Jury Act, 1912, is amended by
inserting the following paragraphs next after paragraph
(p) :—

"(p i) commercial travellers whose usual place of
residence is within the jurors' district for the
city of Sydney, and whose business in that
capacity is carried on outside that district ;

"(p ii) mining managers and under-managers of mines
in which not less than ten men are employed
in mining operations."
