REGISTRATION OF DEEDS (AMENDMENT) ACT.

Act No. 4, 1918.

George V, An Act to amend the Registration of Deeds Act, No. 4. 1897. [Assented to, 12th March, 1918.]

> BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Registration of Deeds (Amendment) Act, 1918."

Material on which registered made.

2. Section seven of the Registration of Deeds Act, 1897, is amended by adding the following proviso at the copy may be end of the section :--

"Provided that the Governor may, by regulations which he is hereby authorised to make, provide that such copy, instead of being upon vellum or parelment may be upon such material as may be specified in such regulations."
