**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

**1.** This Act shall commence on the first day of November, one thousand nine hundred and twenty, and may be cited as the "Parliamentary Representatives Allowance and Ministers' Salaries (Amendment) Act, 1920." Commence-

**2.** Section twenty-eight of the Constitution Act, 1902, as amended by section two of the Parliamentary Representatives Allowance Act, 1912, is further amended— A nendment  
of Constitu-  
tion Act,  
1902, s. 28.

(a) by omitting the words "five hundred" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "eight hundred and seventy-five"; and

(b) by omitting the words "or until Parliament is dissolved or expires by effluxion of time," and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "or, where Parliament has been dissolved or has expired by effluxion of time, until the day appointed for taking the poll for the next general election."

**3.** Subsection one of section forty-one of the Constitution Act, 1902, as amended by subsection one of section two of the Ministers' Salaries Act, 1908, is further amended by omitting the words "twenty thousand three hundred" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "twenty-one thousand two hundred and forty-five." **4.** The Second Schedule to the Constitution Act, 1902, as amended by section four of the Ministers' Salaries Act, 1908, is further amended by omitting all words after the words "Second Schedule," and by inserting in lieu thereof the following words:— Amendment,

Schedule.

**5.** The Third Schedule to the Constitution Act, 1902, as amended by subsection two of section two of the Ministers' Salaries Act, 1908, is further amended—

- (a) by omitting the figures "1,000 0 0" and by inserting in lieu thereof the figures "1,945 0 0"; and
- (b) by omitting the figures "12,250 0 0" and by inserting in lieu thereof the figures "13,195 0 0."

**6.** Section three of the Ministers' Salaries Act, 1908, is amended by omitting the section and by inserting in lieu thereof a new section as follows:—

3. There is hereby specially appropriated out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund an annual amount for the payment, as from the commencement of the Parliamentary Representatives Allowance and Ministers' Salaries (Amendment) Act, 1920, of the salaries of the Ministers of the Crown, being members of the Executive Council, as hereinafter mentioned, at the rate of twenty-three thousand four hundred and twenty pounds per annum—
