

CONVEYANCING (AMENDMENT)

Act No. 15, 1923.

An Act to amend the law with regard to easements of air; and for that purpose to amend the Conveyancing Act, 1919. [Assented to, 25th October, 1923.] George V,

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Conveyancing (Amendment) Act, 1923." Short title.

2. The Conveyancing Act, 1919, is amended by the insertion in section one hundred and seventy-nine after the word "light" of the words "or air." Amendment
