

BANKS AND BANK HOLIDAYS
(AMENDMENT) ACT.

Act No. 25, 1924.

An Act to amend the Banks and Bank Holidays Act, 1912. [Assented to, 10th November, 1924.] George V,

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :--

1. This Act may be cited as the "Banks and Bank Holidays (Amendment) Act, 1924." short title.

2. The Fourth Schedule to the Banks and Bank Holidays Act, 1912, is amended— Amendment

(a) by inserting in Part I after the words "Easter Monday" the words "The twenty-fifth day of April (Anzac Day)"; Fourth

- (b) by omitting from Part I the words "When the first day of January or Christmas Day falls upon a Sunday" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "When the first day of January, or the twenty-sixth day of January, or Christmas Day, or the twenty-sixth day of December falls upon a Sunday";
 - (c) by omitting from Part II the words "The anniversary of the birthday of the Prince of Wales."
