

## DISTRICT COURTS (JUDGES PENSIONS) ACT.

Act No. 30, 1924.

**George V,** An Act to make certain alterations in the pro-  
**No. 30.** visions for the pensions of District Court  
judges; and to amend the District Courts  
Act, 1912, and certain other Acts. [Assented  
to, 3rd December, 1924.]

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty,  
by and with the advice and consent of the Legis-  
lative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South  
Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of  
the same, as follows :—

Short title **1.** This Act may be cited as the “District Courts  
(Judges Pensions) Act, 1924.” **2.**

**2.** The District Courts Act, 1912, is amended as **George V,**  
follows:— **No. 30.**

- (a) By omitting from subsection one of section Amendment  
of District  
Courts Act,  
No. 23 of  
1912. twenty the word “twenty” and inserting in  
lieu thereof the word “fifteen.”
- (b) By omitting from subsection two of the same  
section the word “two” and by inserting in  
lieu thereof the word “three.”
