

## PARLIAMENTARY ALLOWANCES AND SALARIES ACT.

Act No. 6, 1925.

An Act to make further provision with regard to the allowance to members of the Legislative Assembly and the salaries of Ministers of the Crown and of certain other persons; to amend the Constitution Act, 1902, and certain other Acts; to repeal the Ministers' Salaries Act, 1907; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 21st October, 1925.]

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

**1.** (1) This Act may be cited as the "Parliamentary Allowances and Salaries Act, 1925."

(2) The Constitution Act, 1902, as amended by subsequent Acts, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

(3) This Act shall be deemed to have commenced on the first day of July, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-five.

**2.** The Principal Act is amended by omitting from section twenty-eight the words "six hundred" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "eight hundred and seventy-five."

3. The Principal Act is further amended—

- (a) by omitting from section forty-one the words “twenty thousand three hundred,” and by inserting in lieu thereof the words “twenty-one thousand two hundred and forty-five”;
- (b) by omitting from the Third Schedule the figures “1,000 0 0,” and by inserting in lieu thereof the figures “1,915 0 0”;
- (c) by omitting from the said Third Schedule the figures “12,250 0 0,” and by inserting in lieu thereof the figures “13,195 0 0.”

4. There is hereby specially appropriated out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund an annual amount for the payment as from the commencement of this Act of the salaries of the Ministers of the Crown, being members of the Executive Council, as hereinafter mentioned, at the rate of twenty-three thousand four hundred and twenty pounds per annum:—
