

AUCTIONEERS LICENSING (AMENDMENT) ACT.

Act No. 9, 1925.

George V, An Act to amend the Auctioneers Licensing
No. 9. Act, 1898, as amended by subsequent Acts.
[Assented to, 18th November, 1925.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty,
by and with the advice and consent of the Legis-
lative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South
Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of
the same, as follows:—

Short title. **1.** This Act may be cited as the "Auctioneers
Licensing (Amendment) Act, 1925," and shall be read
with the Auctioneers Licensing Act, 1898, as amended
by subsequent Acts, which said Act as so amended is
hereinafter referred to as the Principal Act.

Amendment. **2.** Subsection one of section six of the Principal Act
Act No. 24, is amended by omitting the words "an auctioneer's
1898, s. 6. license" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words
"a general auctioneer's license."
