

AUDIT (AMENDMENT) ACT.

Act No. 12, 1929.

An Act to make further provision with regard to the tenure of office and the salary of the Auditor-General; to amend the Constitution Act, 1902; the Audit Act, 1902, and certain other Acts; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 8th April, 1929.] George V.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Audit (Amendment) Act, 1929." Short title.

(2) This Act shall be deemed to have commenced on the thirtieth day of November in the year one thousand nine hundred and twenty-eight. Commence-
ment.

2. The Audit Act, 1902, is amended by inserting in section nine after the words "good behaviour" the words "until he attains the age of sixty-five years." Amendment of

(Tenure of office.)

3. The Constitution Act, 1902, as amended by subsequent Acts, is amended as follows:— Amendment

- (a) by omitting from subsection one of section forty-one the words "twenty-one thousand two hundred and forty-five" and inserting in lieu thereof the words "twenty-two thousand three hundred and forty-five";
- (b) (i) by omitting from the Third Schedule the figures "900 0 0" and inserting in lieu thereof the figures "2,000 0 0";
- (ii) by omitting from the same Schedule the figures "13,195 0 0" and inserting in lieu thereof the figures "14,295 0 0." s. 3.
