An Act to provide punishment for the malicious George V, or fraudulent abstraction, waste, diverting, No. 26, 1929. consumption, or use of electricity; to amend the Crimes Act, 1900; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 29th October, 1929.]

B^E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :----

Of electricity.

Malicious or fraudulent abstraction, waste, &c., of electricity. 6 & 7 Geo. V, c. 50, s. 10. 154c. Whosoever maliciously or fraudulently abstracts, causes to be wasted or diverted, consumes or uses any electricity, shall be guilty of simple larceny, and punishable accordingly.
