

SYDNEY GRAMMAR SCHOOL
DISENDOWMENT ACT.

Act No. 31, 1931.

An Act to repeal so much of an Act passed in the eighteenth year of the reign of Her late Majesty, Queen Victoria, entitled an Act to incorporate and partially endow the Sydney Grammar School as provides for the payment to the Trustees of that school of an annual endowment of fifteen hundred pounds. [Assented to, 17th August, 1931.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Sydney Grammar School Disendowment Act, 1931."

(2) This Act shall be deemed to have commenced upon the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-one.
