

WESTERN LANDS (FURTHER AMENDMENT) ACT.

Act No. 68, 1931.

An Act to make further provision for the filling of vacancies in the offices of Commissioners of the Western Land Board of New South Wales; to amend the Western Lands Act of 1901, as amended by subsequent Acts; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 29th December, 1931.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Western Lands (Further Amendment) Act, 1931," and shall be read and construed with the Western Lands Act of 1901, as amended by subsequent Acts.

Short title.

2. The Western Lands Act of 1901, as so amended, is amended by inserting in section five after the words "existing term" the words—

(Term of
office.)

Provided that whenever three Commissioners are appointed by the Governor at the same time to fill any vacancies they shall hold office for a term of seven years.
