

SWINE COMPENSATION (AMENDMENT) ACT.

Act No. 10, 1935.

An Act to amend the Swine Compensation Act, 1928, in certain respects; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 6th March, 1935.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Swine Compensation (Amendment) Act, 1935."

(2) The Swine Compensation Act, 1928, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Swine Compensation Act, 1928-1935.

(3) This Act shall commence on the first day of March, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-five.

2. (1) The Swine Compensation Act, 1928, is amended as follows:—

- (a) (i) by omitting from subsection one of section thirteen the words "of every pig slaughtered at such abattoir" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "and to make therein the prescribed entries in respect of every pig delivered to such abattoir for slaughter";
- (ii) by inserting at the end of the same subsection the words "Such entries shall be made within fourteen days after the delivery of the pig";
- (iii) by omitting from subsection two of the same section the words "The owner of every pig to be slaughtered at an abattoir or the agent of such owner" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "Within fourteen days after the delivery of a pig at an abattoir for slaughter the person on whose behalf the pig is so delivered";
- (iv) by omitting from the same subsection the words "to be so slaughtered" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "so delivered";
- (v) by omitting subsection three of the same section;

- (b) by inserting after section sixteen the following new section:—

16A. In any prosecution or other legal proceedings under this or any other Act or under any regulations made thereunder, the record required to be kept at an abattoir in pursuance of this Act, and all entries purporting to be made therein, shall, by the production thereof alone, be prima facie evidence of the facts and matters recorded therein.
