

WESTERN LANDS (AMENDMENT) ACT.

Act No. 8, 1936.

An Act to make further provision in relation to the extension of certain leases to leases in perpetuity; for this purpose to amend the Western Lands Act of 1901, as amended by subsequent Acts; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 8th April, 1936.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Western Lands (Amendment) Act, 1936." Short title.

2. This Act shall be deemed to have commenced on the thirtieth day of December, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-two. Commencement.

3. The Western Lands Act of 1901, as amended by subsequent Acts, is amended by inserting after subsection one of section 18E the following new subsection:—

(1A) The Minister may, in his absolute discretion, refuse to grant any such application.

No other provision of this Act shall be construed so as to prejudice or affect the generality of this subsection.
