## Act No. 35, 1937.

 by repealing enactments which have ceased ${ }^{\mathrm{No} .35,193}$ to be in force or have become unnecessary, by correcting certain errors and inaccuracies in enactments, and by adopting the usual regulation making power in certain Acts: and for purposes connected therewith [Assented to, 23rd December, 13:37.]
$\mathbf{B E}^{\mathrm{E}}$ it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lenislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-

1. This Act may be cited as the "Statute Law Rerision short title. Act, 1937.'
2. The Acts mentioned in the First Schedule to this Repeals. Act are hereby repealed:

Provided that notwithstanding the repeal of any of the Acts mentioned in Part II of the said Schedule or the provisions of section ninety-one of the Public Works Act, 1912, the Constructing Authority under any such Act shall continue to have the same powers, discretions, rights and immunities in respect to making and maintaining fencing along any line of railway constructed under any such Act as if this section had not been enacted.
3. The Aets mentioned in the Second Schedule to this Act are hereby amended in the mamer shown in the said Schedule.
4. (1) The repeal by this Act of any enactment shall not-
(a) revive anything not in force or existing at the time at which the repeal takes effect; or
(b) affect the validity, invalidity, effect, or consequences of anything already done or suffered; or
(c) affect any existing status or capacity; or
(d) affect any right, title, olligation, or liability already acquired, accrued, or incurred, or any remedy or proceeding in respect thereof; or
(e) affect any release or discharge of or from any debt, penalty, obligation, liability, claim or demand; or
(f) affect any indemnity; or
(g) affect the proof of any past act or thing, or the admissibility or inadmissibility of evidence with respect thereto.
(2) The repeal by this Act of any enactment or Schedule shall not affect any enactment in which the enactment or Schedule has been applied, incorporated or referred to.
(3) This Act shall not affect-
(a) any principle or rule of law or equity; or
(b) any established jurisdiction, form or course ot ${ }^{\text {No. 35, }} \underline{-}$ pleading, practice or procedure; or
(c) the general or public nature of any statute; or
(d) any existing usage franchise liberty custom prisilege restriction exemption office appointment payment allowance emolument or benefit; or
(e) any prospective right;
notwithstanding that the same respectively may have been in any manner affirmed recognised or derived by in or from any enactment hereby repealed.
(4) This section shall not limit any saving in the Interpretation Act of 1897.
5. Regulations made under the authority of any Saring as to enactment amended or repealed by the Sccond Schedule regulations. to this Aet and in force at the commencement of this Aet shall not be affected by such amendment or repeal, but may be amended, repealed or replaced by regulations lawfully made after such commencement.
