

MORATORIUM (AMENDMENT) ACT.

No. 28, 1939. An Act to amend the Moratorium Act, 1932-1937,
in certain respects: and for purposes con-
nected therewith. [Assented to, 7th Novem-
ber, 1939.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty,
by and with the advice and consent of the Legis-
lative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South
Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of
the same, as follows:—

Short title
and citation. **1.** (1) This Act may be cited as the “Moratorium
(Amendment) Act, 1939.”

(2) The Moratorium Act, 1932-1937, as amended by
this Act, may be cited as the Moratorium Act, 1932-1939.

2. The Moratorium Act, 1932-1937, is amended—

Sec. 18.
(Prescribed

(a) by omitting from section eighteen the word
“forty” wherever occurring and by inserting in
lieu thereof the word “forty-three”;

Sec. 49.
(Duration
of Part II.)

(b) by omitting from section forty-nine the word
“forty” wherever occurring and by inserting in
lieu thereof the word “forty-three.”
