> BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

- 2. The Moratorium Act, 1932-1937, is amended—
 - (a) by omitting from section eighteen the word "forty" wherever occurring and by inserting in lieu thereof the word "forty-three";
 - (b) by omitting from section forty-nine the word "forty" wherever occurring and by inserting in lieu thereof the word "forty-three."
