

## SYDNEY GRAMMAR SCHOOL (AMENDMENT) ACT.

Act No. 37, 1940.

An Act to amend section three of an Act passed in the eighteenth year of the reign of Her late Majesty, Queen Victoria, entitled An Act to incorporate and partially endow the Sydney Grammar School; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 22nd November, 1940.]

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Sydney Grammar School (Amendment) Act, 1940."

(2) This Act shall commence upon a day to be appointed by the Governor and notified by proclamation published in the Gazette.

(3) The Act passed in the eighteenth year of the reign of Her late Majesty, Queen Victoria, entitled An Act to incorporate and partially endow the Sydney Grammar School, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

(4) The Principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Sydney Grammar School Act, 1854-1940.

**2.** The Principal Act is amended by omitting from section three the words "Colonial Secretary Attorney-General Speaker of the Legislative Council or future Legislative Assembly Provost" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "Attorney-General President of the Legislative Council Speaker of the Legislative Assembly Chancellor."
