

# MARITIME SERVICES (AMENDMENT) ACT.

Act No. 19, 1941.

An Act to amend the Maritime Services Act, 1935, in certain respects; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 9th April, 1941.] George VI.

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

**1.** (1) This Act may be cited as the "Maritime Services (Amendment) Act, 1941." Short title  
and citation.

(2) The Maritime Services Act, 1935, as amended by subsequent Acts and by this Act, may be cited as the Maritime Services Act, 1935-1941.

**2.** The Maritime Services Act, 1935, as amended by subsequent Acts, is amended by omitting from paragraph (c) of subsection one of section three the words "Either the President or the Vice-President" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "One of such three commissioners." Amendment
