RETURNED SAILORS AND SOLDIERS' IMPERIAL LEAGUE OF AUSTRALIA (NEW SOUTH WALES BRANCH) IN-CORPORATION AMENDMENT ACT.

Act No. 2, 1941.

An Act to alter the name of the body corporate George VI. constituted by the Returned Sailors and No. 2, 1941. Soldiers' Imperial League of Australia (New South Wales Branch) Incorporation Act, 1935; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 25th March, 1941.]

Returned Sailors and Soldiers' Imperial League of Australia (New South Wales Branch) Incorporation No. 2, 1941. Amendment Act.

B^E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :---

Short title: citation and commencement.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Returned Sailors and Soldiers' Imperial League of Australia (New South Wales Branch) Incorporation Amendment Act, 1941."

(2) The Returned Sailors and Soldiers' Imperial League of Australia (New South Wales Branch) Incorporation Act, 1935, is referred to in this Act as the Principal Act.

(3) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Returned Sailors, Soldiers and Airmen's Imperial League of Australia (New South Wales Branch) Incorporation Act, 1935–1941.

(4) This Act shall commence upon a day to be appointed by the Governor and notified by proclamation published in the Gazette.

2. The Principal Act is amended by inserting next Amendment of Act No. 39, after section three the following new section :---

Change of name of corporation.

3A. (1) As from the commencement of the Returned Sailors and Soldiers' Imperial League of Australia (New South Wales Branch) Incorporation Amendment Act, 1941–

- (a) the name of the body corporate constituted by section three of this Act shall be "The Returned Sailors, Soldiers and Airmen's Imperial League of Australia (New South Wales Branch)";
- (b) a reference in any Act or other instrument to The Returned Sailors and Soldiers' Imperial League of Australia (New South Wales Branch) shall be read and construed as a reference to The Returned Sailors, Soldiers and Airmen's Imperial League of Australia (New South Wales Branch).

(2) Nothing contained in the Returned Sailors and Soldiers' Imperial League of Australia (New South Wales Branch) Incorporation Amendment Act, 1941,

1941, shall prejudice or affect in any way the N_0 . 2, 1941. continuity of the body corporate constituted by section three of this Act, but the same shall continue notwithstanding the provisions of the said Act.

(3) The alteration of name effected by subsection one of this section--

- (a) shall not prejudice or affect the continuity of the body corporate constituted by section three of this Act;
- (b) shall not affect any property, powers, rights, authorities, duties, functions, liabilities or obligations of the said body corporate, or render defective any legal or other proceedings instituted or to be instituted by or against the said body corporate.

Any legal or other proceedings may be continued or commenced by or against the corporation by the name of The Returned Sailors, Soldiers and Airmen's Imperial League of Australia (New South Wales Branch) that might have been continued or commenced by or against the corporation by the name of the Returned Sailors and Soldiers' Imperial League of Australia (New South Wales Branch).
