

FIRE BRIGADES (AMENDMENT) ACT.

Act No. 23, 1941.

An Act to extend the application of the Fire Brigades Act, 1909-1927, to certain ports and navigable waters; to amend the said Act in certain respects; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 9th April, 1941.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Fire Brigades (Amendment) Act, 1941."

(2) The Fire Brigades Act, 1909-1927, as amended by subsequent Acts and by this Act, may be cited as the Fire Brigades Act, 1909-1941.

(3) This Act shall commence upon a day to be appointed by the Governor and notified by proclamation published in the Gazette.

(d) Port Jackson, the Port of Newcastle, Port Kembla, and any other navigable waters to which the Board, with the consent of the Minister, may, by notification in the Gazette, apply this Act.

(b) by inserting in subsection one of section nineteen, after the words "or any part thereof" the words "and in or upon any port or navigable waters to which this Act applies";

(c) by inserting after paragraph (g) of section twenty the following new paragraph:—

(h) establish, maintain and conduct fire fighting services in and in respect of any port or navigable waters to which this Act applies.

(d) by inserting after section thirty-seven the following new section:—

37A. (1) All moneys required by the Board to meet the costs and expenses arising out of the application of this Act to ports and navigable waters in pursuance of paragraph (d) of subsection one of section four shall be paid to the Board by the Colonial Treasurer out of moneys provided by Parliament.

(2) Moneys paid to the Board under this section shall be paid into the fund and a separate account thereof shall be kept showing the amounts so paid to the Board and the amounts expended for and in respect of ports and navigable waters to which this Act applies.

(3) Moneys paid to the Board under this section shall be applied by the Board for the purposes for which it has been provided by Parliament.
