

MORATORIUM (AMENDMENT) ACT.

Act No. 24, 1942.

George VI. An Act to amend the Moratorium Act, 1932-
No. 24, 1942. 1939, in certain respects; and for purposes
connected therewith. [Assented to, 18th
November, 1942.]

BE

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, No. 24, 1942.
by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Moratorium Short title and citation.
(Amendment) Act, 1942."

(2) The Moratorium Act, 1932, as amended by subsequent Acts and by this Act, may be cited as the Moratorium Act, 1932-1942.

2. The Moratorium Act, 1932-1939, is amended—

- (a) by omitting from section eighteen the word "forty-three" wherever occurring and by inserting in lieu thereof the word "forty-six"; Amendment of Act No. 57, 1932. Sec. 18. (Prescribed date for repayment.)
- (b) by omitting from section forty-nine the word "forty-three" wherever occurring and by inserting in lieu thereof the word "forty-six." Sec. 49. (Duration of Part II.)
